

STAS Minirail Picture Hanging System

A STAS Minirail picture hanging system has been installed in the Supper Room. A box is available containing 14 perlon cords, 20 smartspring hooks and 10 zipper hooks - see attached diagram.

The hook on the end of the perlon cord fits easily in to the rail which is located on the supper room wall. Cords can be moved along the rail as needed. The hooks can then be slid on to the cord at an appropriate height for hanging the picture. Multiple pictures can be hung on a single cord, or multiple cords can be used for a single picture.

The minirail will sustain 55 lb/yd. The smartspring hook is for loads up to 8.8 lbs. The zipper hook is for loads up to 33 lbs. The perlon cords should not be cut as this may create a burr, making it difficult to slide the picture hook onto the cord. We recommend rolling up the overflowing piece of cord and tucking it away behind your artwork (if necessary, use an elastic band, some tape or a paperclip).
